# CAPITAL OUTLAY BUREAU Capital Projects Monitoring System

#### What we do?

## The Capital Outlay Bureau (COB) is responsible for:

- Coordinate the funding and administration of capital projects.
- Work closely with executive agencies and Governor to prepare the Executive Capital Budget.
- Oversee the capital budgeting process:
  - The questionnaire process;
  - Identifying local entities;
  - EO Compliance; and
  - Budgeting capital projects.
- Maintain the State Capital Project Monitoring System (CPMS).
- Monitor the expiration dates of all capital appropriations to ensure timely reversions of expired appropriation balances.
- Provide training, assistance and oversight to state and local agencies on the planning, project management and administration of capital project appropriations, including the Infrastructure Capital Improvement Plan (ICIP) for State Agencies.

# Capital Projects Monitoring System (CPMS)

- CPMS is a web-based system used for reporting and monitoring of capital outlay appropriations
- Used by:
  - Legislative Finance Committee (LFC).
  - Press and general public.
- Local entities begin reporting once a grant agreement has been executed.
  - Local entity is required to update appropriation information on monthly basis by the 30th of each month (IGA)

## **Required Periodic Reports**

- Paperless reports in Capital Projects Management System (CPMS)
  - ✓ Start reporting once appropriation is made
  - ✓ Due 30<sup>th</sup> of each month from execution until project is complete: <a href="http://cpms.dfa.state.nm.us">http://cpms.dfa.state.nm.us</a>


- New Online Capital Outlay Dashboard for local capital projects.

#### **Key Terms & Definitions**

Agency	The state agency assigned to the project.
Appropriation Year	Year in which funds were appropriated.
Balance	The current unexpended balance of the project.
Capital Project Type	Each project is categorized by a project type.
County	The county in which the project resides.
Executed	The grant agreement has been issued, signed and returned by the local entity and has been signed by the state agency.
Funding Source	The source of funding for each project. (GF, STB, GOB, etc.)
FY	Fiscal Year. (July 1 through June 30)
Grant Agreement	An agreement between a state agency and local entity for use of the funds for a project.
Grant Agreement Phase	The current status of the grant agreement. (Not Issued, Issued, or Executed)
Issued	The grant agreement has been issued to the local entity but has not been signed and returned or signed by the state agency.
Last Updated By Local	The date the local entity last updated the project in CPMS.
Local Fiscal Agent	Local entity responsible for the project.
No Activity	Indicates a project for which no expenditures have been reported.
Not Issued	The grant agreement has not been issued to the local entity.
Project Detail	Specifications of the project (Year, title, project number, etc.)
Reversion Year	Year in which funds will be reverted.
Total Approp/Reauth	The amount of funding appropriated or reauthorized for the project.
% Expended	The percentage of the total appropriation that has been expended.
Up to 25%	Up to 25% of the funds have been expended for this project.
26% to 50%	26% to 50% of the funds have been expended for this project.
51% to 75%	51% to 75% of the funds have been expended for this project.
76% to 100%	76% to 100% of the funds have been expended for this project.
% Balance	The percentage of the total appropriation that remains to be expended.
Expended Range	The percentage of the total appropriation that has been expended, in ranged categories.
