

Updates


- CDBG moved to Infrastructure Planning and Development Division
- NMAC Rule Amendment in progress
- CDC approved the use of our 2024 allocation for supplemental funding
- Goal for 2024 was getting open projects closed –currently have 48
- CDC approved some changes for 2025 to improve flexibility and competition



2025 Improvements

- No cap on grant amount for this year
- No match required for rural applications (nonrural applications still require 10% match) for this year
- Now requiring a professional external project administrator for each applicant*
- Mostly the same application, but it is shorter
