USE OF FUNDS

HB 253 (§7-27-51 NMSA 1978) specifies that the fund shall be used **“to fund capital projects with a total cost of less than five million dollars (\$5,000,000) and only the planning and design of capital projects with a total cost greater than that amount.”**

- Projects with a total cost of less than \$5M
 - Useable phase
 - Existing funding
 - Return to original scope

CDPF GRANT TIMELINE - 2026

- CDPF projects will be included in the 2026 capital outlay bill
- Bill voted on by both houses of the legislature
- Signed by the Governor on or before March 11, 2026
- Questionnaires sent to awardees in May, 2026
- Funds available for use on July 1, 2026

Useable Phase:

- As included in the Grant Management Guidelines, a “useable phase” means **a distinct portion of a capital project that has been sufficiently completed and meets all applicable safety, operational, and regulatory requirements such that it can be safely and effectively occupied, operated, or used for its intended purpose, even if other phases of the overall project are still to be initiated or completed.**




